Communication & Language

- Children will use a variety of communication strategies as recommended by their speech and language therapist. This will help children to choose within the continuous provision environment.
- Children will also be encouraged to interact with adults through one to one interactions including intensive interaction.
- Children will join group sessions for some adult led learning.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Children will be offered opportunities to play and explore together as part of continuous provision.
- Children will spend time with their key workers in adult led focused sessions.
- Children will have time to relax in the afternoon ready to learn and enjoy a massage or explore with sensory items.
- Children will continue to follow a daily routine which will include teeth brushing
- Children will be encouraged to play alongside and with a partner in smaller group sessions

Understanding of the world

- Children will be exploring resources linked to babies and looking at photographs of when they were a baby.
- Imaginative play will be explored and encouraged through dressing up and small world superhero figures.

Physical Development

- This half term children will be enjoying lots of time being physical outside.
- There will be some PD activities in the hall with a focus on moving in different ways. This will include some children's physiotherapy work.
- Children will also have fun getting physical in ready to learn activities. This will include the use of equipment such as standing frames and walkers.
- Fine motor skills will be encouraged in sensory food play activities and dough disco.

Expressive art and design

- Children will begin to explore rhythm through music. We will use our names to make a beat and explore a variety of instruments.

Literacy

- Children will continue to become familiar with symbols and signs.
- We will explore a wide range of books including a sensory story.
- There will be opportunity for children to mark make in a range of sensory materials.

Mathematics

- Children will play with superhero resources and place figures in messy play trays and on top of construction toys.
- Children will be encouraged to stack and connect through continuous provision play.
